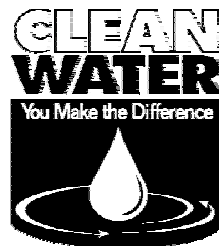

## Facility Risk Evaluation Program (FREP)

The Risk Evaluation Program provides small business within the Battle Creek area the opportunity to participate in an environmental evaluation of their business performed by a professional consultant.

This program is being offered on a one-time only basis and is being paid for by grant monies made available to the City of Battle Creek for businesses within its drinking water protection areas.

### The FREP Offers:

Free, confidential, environmental risk assessments.

### Benefits Include:

- Protecting drinking water
- Identifying environmental BMPs
- Understanding of environmental standards
- Potential cost savings

### Eligibility

Small to medium-sized business within the Wellhead Protection Areas of the City of Battle Creek will be considered. Space is limited and the Wellhead Protection Team, comprised of business and municipal representatives, will determine final eligibility.

A business's environmental performance is increasingly viewed as an essential part of good business and good citizenship. Businesses within the City's wellhead protection areas have a special responsibility to follow pollution prevention measures because the health of our community's drinking water depends on it!
