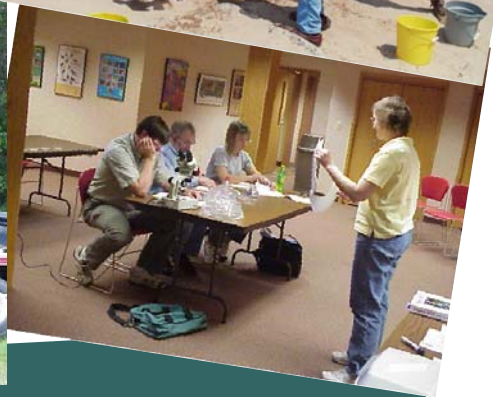


# Groundwater Teacher Training Camp June 13—June 17, 2005
